### 3 Teaching and Learning

**Goal 1** *Ensure that a contemporary approach to teaching and learning is implemented within the school*

*Strategies for Goal 1*

- 1.1 Provide clarification of the characteristics of what is “Contemporary Learning”
- 1.2 Ensure that our collective school-wide approach to teaching and learning is based on research, data and best practice.
- 1.3 Design learning sequences that provide opportunities for metacognition and for students and staff to engage in reflective practice

**Goal 2** *Develop sound understanding of the Australian Curriculum which is reflected in school developed Scope and Sequences, teaching programmes and assessment strategies.*

*Strategies for Goal 2*

- 2.1 Provide professional development for each of the Curriculum areas
- 2.2 Compose scope and sequences and learning programmes based on the needs of students utilising powerful models of student inquiry
- 2.3 Provide Professional Learning to enhance teachers’ understanding and implementation of formative and summative strategies to better inform student growth and inform cycles of learning

**Goal 3** *Ensure that a personalised and multimodal pedagogy is embedded across the curriculum*

*Strategies for Goal 3*

- 3.1 Implement and continue to refine the practice of designing short cycles to maximise use of student growth data
- 3.2 Produce policies and procedures around the appropriate use of technology
- 3.3 Promote a balance between traditional teaching practices and digital pedagogy
- 3.4 Instilling a culture of targeted SMART goal setting for students and staff

**Goal 4** *Implement professional dialogue within the school / PLT’s that is informed by feedback, analysis of current research and practice to improve educational outcomes of students*

*Strategies for Goal 4*

- 4.1 PLT’s designed around student gathered data
- 4.2 Investigate best practice of providing meaningful feedback
- 4.3 Embed professional sharing opportunities
- 4.4 Implement and utilise a wide range of data resources to support students in their learning

**Goal 5** *To provide a differentiated curriculum and opportunities for intervention*

*Strategies for Goal 5*



- 5.1 Provide appropriate Professional Development to support staff in providing responsive interventions
- 5.2 Develop a CASL approach as a catalyst to providing timely and intentional intervention
- 5.3 Develop the understanding of assessment of learning for learning - focus on formative and summative assessment
